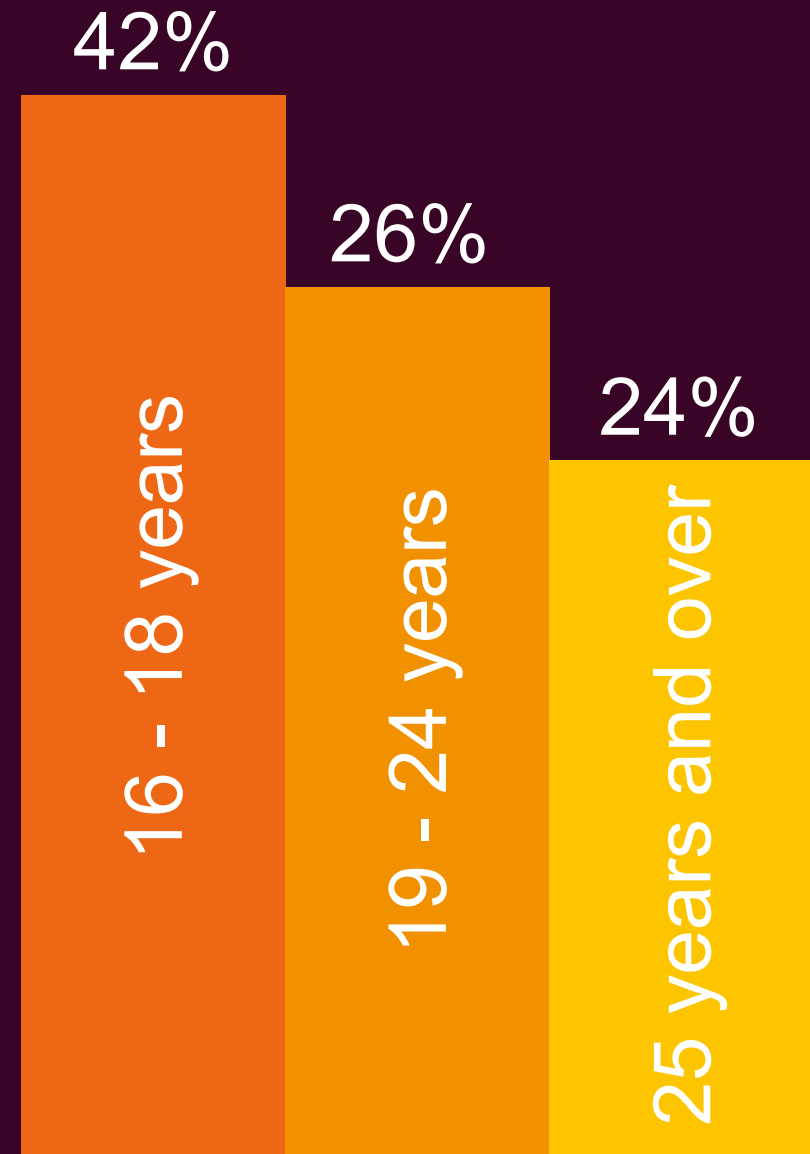

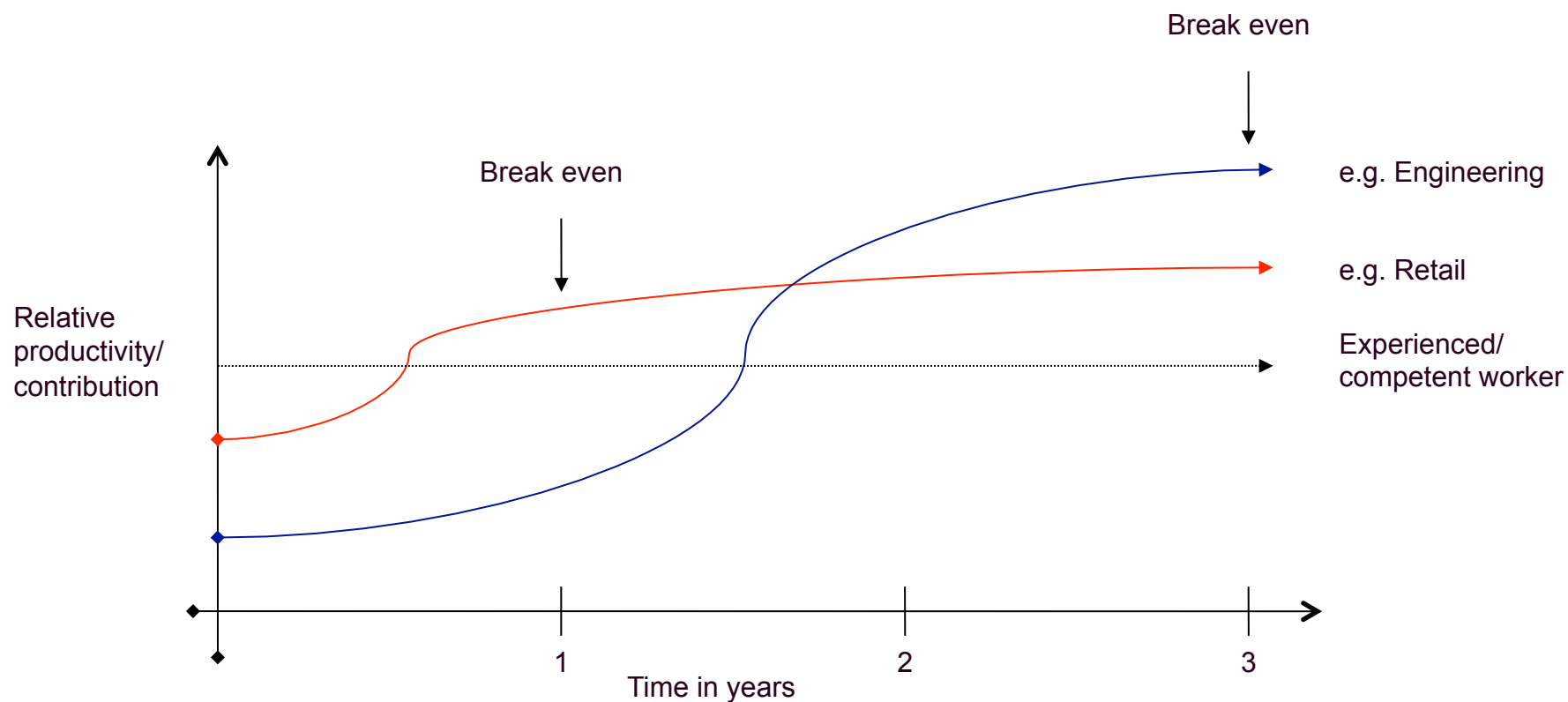


In the year 2008/09 a quarter of a million people started an Apprenticeship

A quarter of a million Apprenticeships in 2008/09

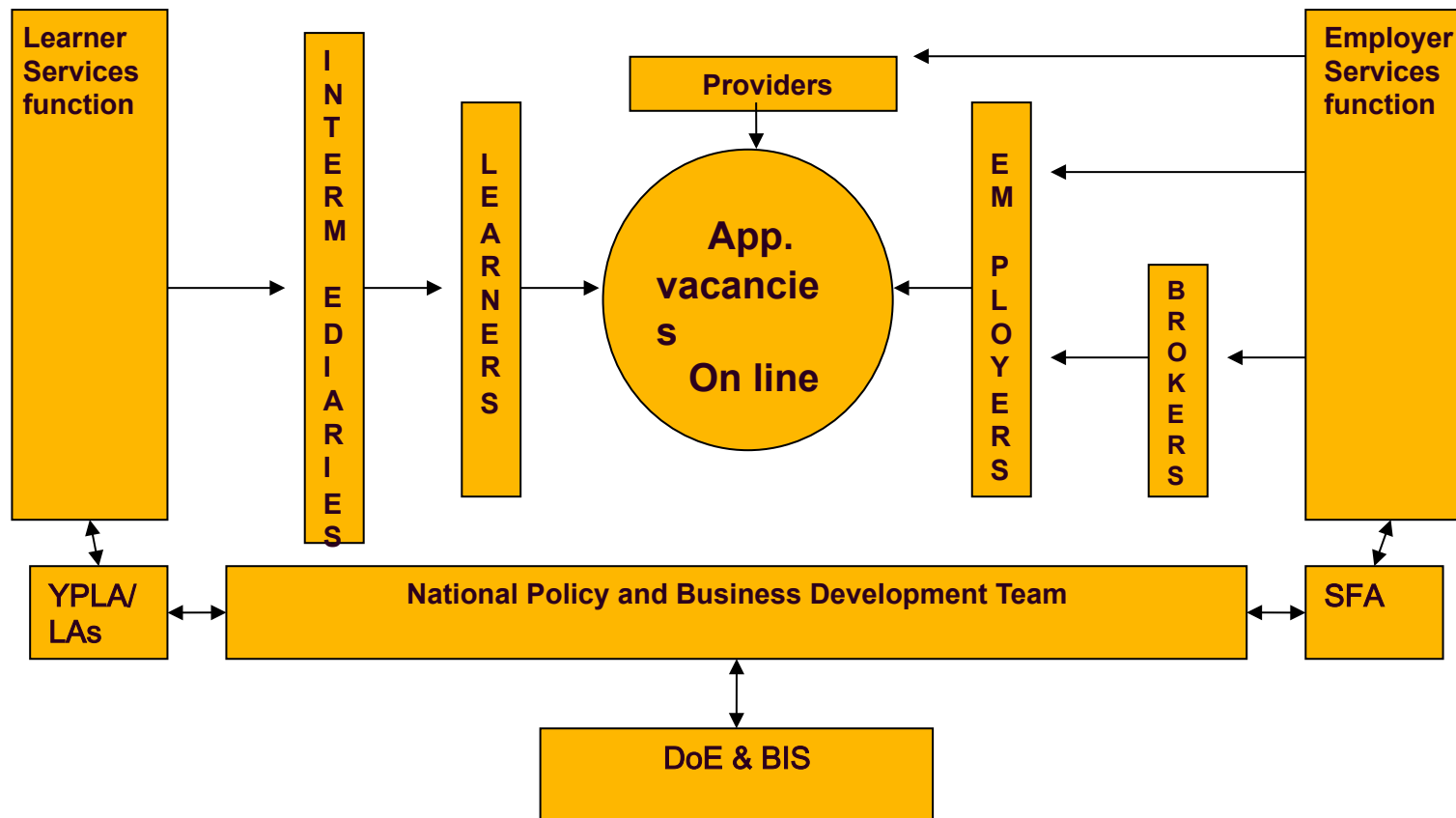

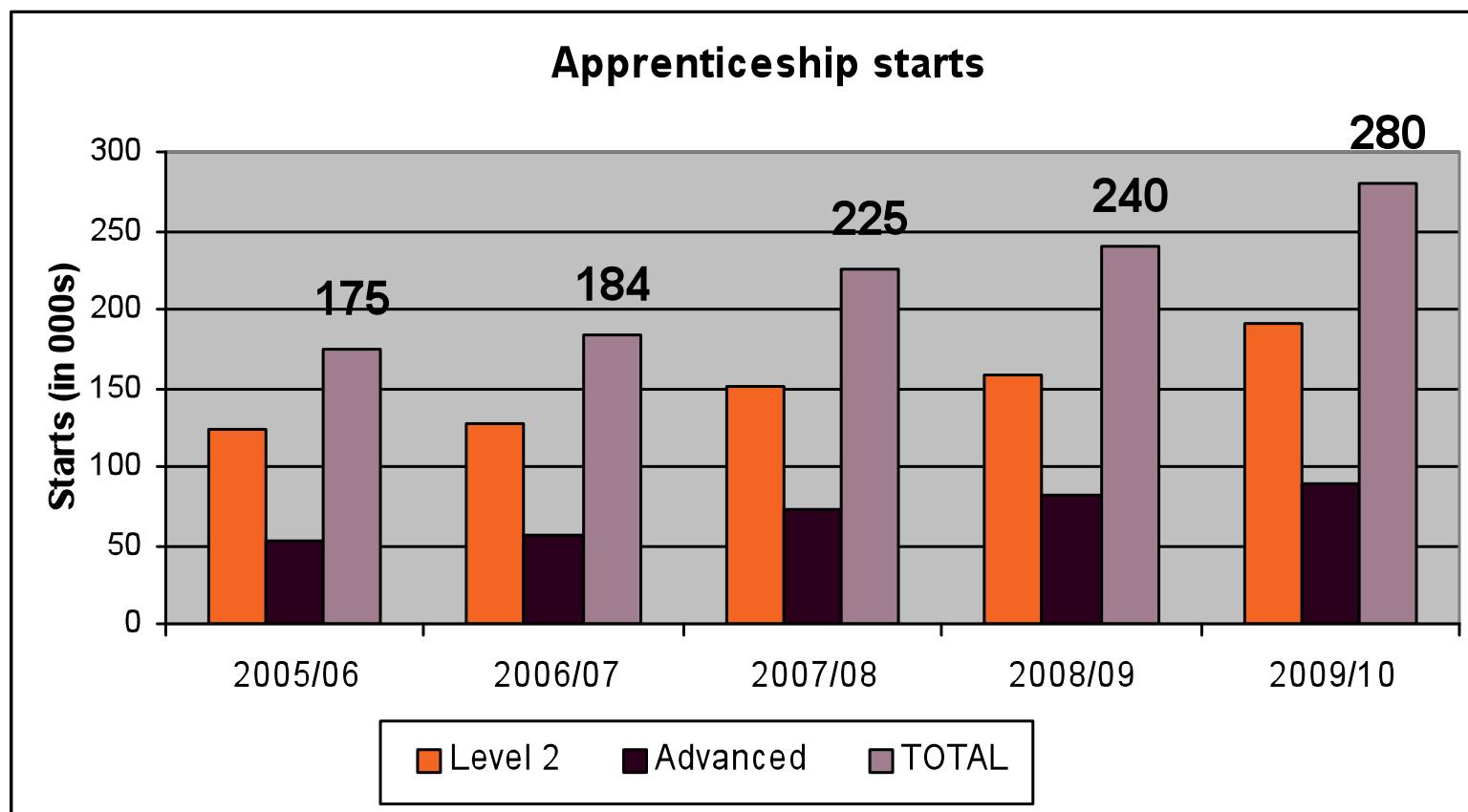

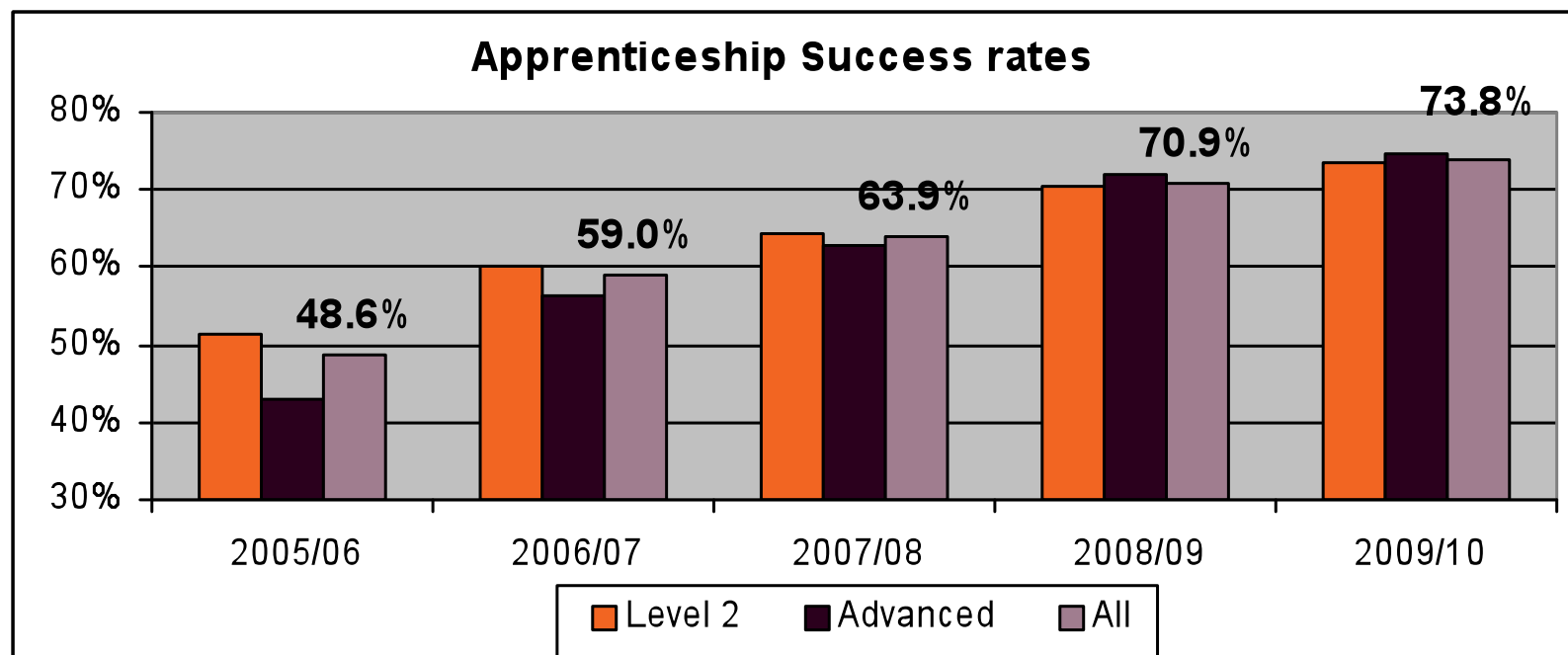


Rising numbers of apprentices



- 162,000 people started an Apprenticeship in 2001/02
- Over 300,000 people are expected to start an Apprenticeship in 2010/11

Success rates



In 2001/02 – 76% of starters did not complete their Apprenticeship programme
 In 2009/10 – 74% of starters successfully completed their programme
